Задание 1 (50 баллов).

Read the text (below). The text is part of a scholarly article. It is not terribly difficult to understand. However, it would help a lot if you read it attentively. After reading and rereading it, you are to provide detailed answers to four questions. Do not cite the text when answering the questions! Then you are to write an abstract (approximately 100-150 words). The abstract is to convey the contents of the text correctly.

You will find input windows to type in your answers to four questions and the abstract after the text.

Вопрос 1. In what methodological perspective was this text written?

Вопрос 2. What is a «white elephant»? You are not to answer by giving a direct quote from the text. Instead you are to explain this phenomenon and to give examples.

Вопрос 3. «White elephants» are often treated as the «worst symptoms of the megalomania of rulers». Yet, creators of «white elephants» are not lunatics. What is the logic behind the policies leading to initiation of «white elephants» (as proposed by the authors of the text)?

Вопрос 4. «White elephants» are not infrequently presented as a feature of autocracies. Are democracies completely immune from policies leading to «white elephants»?

Задание 2 (50 баллов).

If you find our topics (and our Programme) challenging and worth, you are to write an academic essay on the topic you like. Your essay is to be written in English. Good luck!

1. Much ink has been spilled over the past decade on the question of “populism”. Discussions of its content, its relationship to society, its communicative and emotional style, and its consequences for democracy have made frequent appearances on TV screens and in academia respectively. What

should we make of this phenomenon? Is populism something that should be avoided as a harmful and demagogic movement to the body politic or embraced as a core feature of democratic politics?

2. Much of the 20th century political science literature has view political behavior through the lens of rationality. Irrational components of the human psychology, however, such as emotions, may also play a role in influencing the individual to make political decisions. What role, if any, does affect play in political decision-making and what implications does this have for democratic politics?

3. In the 2015 essay “The Coddling of the American Mind” in the Atlantic magazine Greg Lukianoff and Jonathan Haidt claimed that “Attempts to shield students from words, ideas, and people that might cause them emotional discomfort are bad for the students... When the ideas, values, and speech of the other side are seen not just as wrong but as willfully aggressive toward innocent victims, it is hard to imagine the kind of mutual respect, negotiation, and compromise that are needed to make politics a positive-sum game.” Nevertheless, certain ideas, values, and people are kept out of classes on a regular basis all over the world. What are the most cited arguments to keep certain “ideas, values, and people” out of classes? Should all ideas, values, and people be “admitted” to classes? What is the relationship (if any) between the evolution of politics (in a particular country or in general) and the perception of “ideas, values, and people” as appropriate in classes?

4. Though a genuine AI is nowhere near, we can observe enormous advances in R&D and application of advanced algorithms. Popular culture and futurologists have already constructed believable and rather grim futures in which evil AIs destroy or enslave humans. How can existential threats from the AI be avoided? What political and ethical problems are to be solved to make intelligent machines human friendly?

5. The World Economic Forum is pushing forward a concept of “the Great Reset”. What is this concept? What are its economic and political implications?

1. General scope and coverage of the task: how many questions have been answered; how elaborate are the answers? 0 – 20
